





You can climb live volcanoes and have breakfast near the crater rim; explore dense jungles bursting with colour and exotic wildlife; and shallow dive to amazing shipwrecks and planes downed during WWII. Cruising from one secluded, pristine sand beach to another, you can swim with dolphins, take part in turtle conservation, and spend the night on an uninhabited island, foraging and fishing for your supper with the help of a guide.

And the adventure continues. You can surf and kayak on turquoise seas around Nusa, take a



helicopter journey to see the smoked corpses in Aseki, and enjoy a front row seat to the explosive Bainings Fire Dance ceremony.





Seychelles BACK TO BASICS

4.08° S / 55.53° E

WHEN TO GO: APRIL TO MAY & OCTOBER TO NOVEMBER



The exotic islands of the Seychelles offer the perfect experience for those who are looking to get back to nature and to enjoy a slower pace of life. With a population of less than 95,000, its 115 islands are a haven for wildlife, with many unique native species both on land and in the water. Mahé island is home to the capital Victoria, where you can tour the National Botanical Gardens before taking a hike through the mountain rainforests of Morne Seychellois National Park.

Aldabra Atoll, to the south of the island group, has UNESCO World Heritage status protection. As the world's largest raised coral atoll, its protected lagoon is a veritable aquarium of turtles, fishes, rays and undamaged coral reef. Ashore, explore the rugged landscape, home to one of the world's largest populations of giant tortoises, as well as oceanic nesting flamingos, green turtles and rare birds.

The beach at La Digue is world famous for its pristine beauty, while the diving in Desroches



Island lagoon near Victoria is spectacular. For shallow-water snorkelling, try Faquar Atoll's lagoon, which offers protected waters for kids to get close to the action.

Costa Rica

RICH IN BIODIVERSITY

8.54° N / 83.58° W

WHEN TO GO: DECEMBER TO APRIL



Costa Rica's Pacific coast offers excellent access to an array of natural wonders, both in the water and ashore. Corcovado National Park and the nearby Osa Peninsula have been called "the most biologically intense place on Earth" and are best explored on horseback, on foot or by ziplining for an aerial view, like a toucan in flight.

The Rio Coto's mangroves near the coast put you in the heart of a buzzing hub of tropical species, from noisy howler monkeys and inquisitive capuchins to scarlet macaws and three-toed sloths. Take a tender trip up the estuary or travel under your own steam on a kayak or paddleboard. Alternatively, Manuel Antonio National Park further north features rainforest trekking as well as pristine sandy beaches and snorkelling on coral reefs.

Isla Caño is a hotspot for marine wildlife, and a great



place to visit from the comfort of a luxury yacht. Voted the country's top diving spot, keep an eye out for eagle rays, turtles, reef sharks and colourful tropical fish. There is a beginner-level wreck dive for novices and the Devil's Pinnacle is a must-see highlight for intermediate divers. Seasonal humpback whale migrations offer the chance to spot the enigmatic species along the Pacific coast, from December to March and August to December.

Mexico

THE WORLD'S AQUARIUM

24.48° N / 110.34° W

WHEN TO GO: DECEMBER TO MARCH



The Sea of Cortez, also known as the World's Aquarium, is a natural haven nestled between the Baja California peninsula and Mexico's mainland. Baja is the second-longest peninsula in the world, extending out over 1,200km to offer sheltered, rugged and mysterious waters to cruise by yacht.

The region is popular with those seeking a peaceful break as well as those who like to explore and adventure in nature-rich destinations. The Sea of Cortez features a UNESCO World Heritage Site comprising 244 islands and coastal areas, and many travellers come to see the migrating whale sharks between December and April.

The Marine Protected Area at Cabo Pulmo offers sanctuary to all manner of wildlife, being one of the most successful marine parks in the world. Isla Espíritu Santo to the north of La Paz is regarded by many as the most beautiful island in the Sea of Cortez. The uninhabited lunar landscape is a superb backdrop to a coastal cruise through gem-hued waters with bright white beaches ripe for barefoot exploration.

The reefs surrounding the island are teeming with the likes of parrotfish, angelfish and trumpetfish as well as sharks, rays, turtles, dolphins and whales. A local colony of sea lions to the north offers plenty of entertainment for spectators and a chance to snorkel with these playful sea mammals.

To the north of Turkish yachting hotspot Bodrum lies Ephesus, a once hugely important commercial centre for the ancient world and today one of the best-preserved historical cities in Europe. Founded by the Greeks in the 10th-century BC, it went on to expand significantly under rule of the Roman Empire and is thought to be the location where St John wrote his gospel for the Bible.

From here you can jump in a kayak to explore the 10 historical cave painting sites, passing through mangroves and limestone sea caves along the way. There are hundreds of separate paintings in the caves depicting everyday life, including human figures, birds, lobsters and

to visit the fascinating floating Muslim village of Koh Panyi, where fishermen live beneath the sheer

limestone cliffs in houses on stilts.

crocodiles. They are thought to have been created by the Sea Peoples, who still live on the small islands of the Andaman Sea.

While in Krabi, the energetic among your group can make their way up to the Tiger Cave Temple. With its large golden Buddha statue at the summit of a staircase with 1,237 steps, a panoramic view of the lush tropical rainforest surroundings and coastline awaits. For those who would rather take things easily, the lower foothills area is inhabited by local Buddhist monks as well as a network of caves that have been transformed into shrines.

SUBMERGED ANCIENT CITY

WHEN TO GO: MAY TO SEPTEMBER



The Gulf of Naples is well known for the historical eruption of Mount Vesuvius and resulting destruction of the city of Pompeii. But few are aware of the mysterious wonders that lie under the water's surface across the Gulf from the site of Pompeii, at a completely unique site like no other in the world.

The Underwater Archaeological Park of Baiae, also known as the Submerged Baia Park, is a protected area in the Phlegraean Fields to the west of the city of Naples that was once a favoured residential settlement for the aristocracy of the Roman Empire, having been founded by the Greeks in the eighth century BC due to its central location in the Tyrrhenian Sea. Emperors and noble families built grand and luxurious seaside villas along this picturesque stretch of water and the Phlegrean Coast became a hotspot for high society, politics, finance and trading, not to mention culture and

entertainment. But the volcanic nature of the territory meant that, over the centuries, much of this ancient city has slipped into the sea in a slow vertical movement.

Today, you can pull on a snorkel, mask and a pair of fins to explore the beautifully preserved sights of this watery window into the past thanks to the Archaeology Diving Tours project. Experienced underwater guides will lead you on a customised tour down the submerged ancient streets, taking in the once buzzing thermal baths, the villas of celebrated wealthy families, the sacred nymphaeums (shrines dedicated to nymphs that were important to the Romans), and the port with its warehouses storing goods for trading.

Everyday details of the ancient civilisation will come to life before your eyes, with colourful mosaics, flooring and columns from opulent villas next to restored or replica statues discovered by archaeologists. Highlights of the tours include a stop at the famous nymphaeum of Emperor Claudius and the Villa dei Pisoni, a renowned Roman family that plotted against Emperor Nerone.

Once you have chosen to buy a new-build yacht, there are no doubt several questions that will soon follow. The range of options on the market allows you to balance a number of factors, not only encompassing price and length but also speed of delivery and degree of customisation.

In 2017, there were 187 new-build yachts of 30 metres or more ordered and acquired (compared with 262 preowned yachts sold), and in that same year, there were 147 yachts of 30 metres or more completed, having been ordered by owners in previous years or built speculatively*.

What might this mean for you as an owner looking to buy a new build yacht rather than one that has been previously owned? As demand for new build superyachts has risen in recent years, build slots have become harder to secure, particularly for fully custom yachts at the most prestigious yards in Northern Europe. But that is not to say that there are not plenty of attractive options at pedigree yards.

For many long-term owners, the time comes to build their dream yacht with all the facilities, capacity and details that

they have learned are right for their needs. Additional time is needed for fully custom engineering and design work, both technical and aesthetic. But for many owners, the longer wait time is worth it.

There is an excellent range of yards now offering semicustom new-build platforms. This option reduces the overall waiting time and the number of technical decisions to be made (see overleaf for our informative diagram on this subject). It is an attractive option, as it delivers a proven platform that has been refined over time.

Of course, the more aesthetic choices for interiors will still be available to ensure the yacht feels truly special. But the waiting time for pre-engineering and technical design work is reduced or completely eliminated. In some cases, construction on a semicustom yacht project might have already been started by the yard before the contract is signed, further reducing waiting time for the owner.

Overall, a semi-custom choice can reduce the delivery time by a third or more, compared with a fully custom

superyacht. The production yacht option offers the least flexibility in terms of design, layout and interior. The resulting pay-off is a much-reduced wait until delivery. This can be a great option for first-time buyers.





BUYING & OWNING

A YACHT BERTH

YOU HAVE JUST BOUGHT A NEW YACHT AND NEED TO CHOOSE HER HOME PORT AND BERTH. WHAT ARE THE CONSIDERATIONS AND WHERE DO YOU START?

INHERITING A BERTH

When you buy a pre-owned yacht, you do not automatically get to keep the home berth that was used by the previous owners, and the marina may have the right to prevent the berth being included in the sale. This is not usually an issue. If the berth is a short-term rental then the captain's relationship with the port office will be key in keeping the berth for the foreseeable future.

ROAM VS HOME

Home berths are not obligatory, and the majority of yachts over 40m tend to rent them instead. But there are a number of advantages to buying a berth rather than always renting one:

SECURITY: With the increasing number of 70m+ yachts

being launched and the limited number of superyacht berths available, demand will soon outstrip supply, especially in the sought-after ports and luxury marinas of the Mediterranean. Owning a home berth gives you peace of mind in having a berth readily available.

LONGEVITY: A home berth helps to increase crew longevity. This continuity improves the owner and charterer experience on board by having a happier, more efficient and more knowledgeable crew.

SAVINGS: Compared to a monthly basis, a long-term lease is cheaper than renting. When the berth is not in use, rental income can offset or even cover the costs on the yacht's berth rentals in other marinas.

MONEY MATTERS

A yacht's home berth is not just a place to keep it when you are not cruising; there can be financial implications to the location you pick, too. The tax advantage of Porto Montenegro and being able to export the yacht is the most

significant VAT advantage that can be had when buying a berth. The TPA programme is also a good option at OneOcean Port Vell, allowing qualifying yachts to carry out VAT-free repairs and maintenance for a limited period.

A long-term lease berth price is paid as a single, initial lump sum excluding annual maintenance costs and marina fees. It is customary for there to be a commission payable to the broker involved in the berth purchase, which varies depending on the situation and could be between 5% and 10%, and there may also be a transfer fee and VAT.

TAKING YOUR TIME

The leases for home port berths range from two to 57 years, with the most common being around 20 years. You can sell the lease before it has expired by using a reputable brokerage company such as YACHTZOO.


